

It was a great experience being a judge the Golden Gavel competition. Having been a spectator and a dummy bidder in past competitions it was interesting to see the criteria and weighting for judging the auction performances.

The quality of the auctioneers in both the Senior and Rising Star heats was outstanding. Even experienced Auctioneers can have an attack of nerves and having seen most of the Senior Auctioneers perform live auctions it is fairly apparent that being in a auction competition is much more difficult than auctioneering in the field.

The nature of the competition requires a performance in front of your peers whilst being judged. It puts pressure on all auction skill components and it is interesting to see how the competitors perform against each other. The standard achieved was incredibly high and even the lowest marked performance would be a great performance under less trying conditions.

The usual and expected hurdles are placed in the way of competitors, not to trip them up necessarily, but to see how various situations are handled. It is a credit to the competitors that most situations were expertly handled, even though some stumbled mainly due to perceived pressure rather than difficulty.

It is without doubt that competitors gain valuable auctioneering experience from entering the competition as the training and time taken to fine tune their auctioneering skills for the competition must assist them when conducting auctions for their clients.

AND/ORNOMINEE

There is now no need to execute a contract as purchaser "and or nominee" from recent ruling by RevenueSA and there is no need to produce a letter of nomination to the conveyancer. However, the conveyancer would still need a Deed of Assignment when the transferee or assignee is a third party and when there is an extra consideration being paid by the end purchaser.

RevenueSA also acknowledges that the purchaser under a Contract has a common law right to direct the vendor to transfer the land at settlement to any person or entity the purchaser desires. This common law right exists irrespective of whether the purchaser has executed the Contract "and/or nominee" or not.

However, where an Assignment is still executed (e.g. where a transferee requests an Assignment of the purchaser's contractual interest to them), duty will continue to be payable on the Assignment, calculated on the greater of the consideration paid for the Assignment or the full market value of the interest assigned.

In the majority of situations, the amount assessed on the Assignment will be equal to the deposit paid by the purchaser under the Contract, unless the market value of the land has increased since the date of the Contract. In addition, duty is also payable

on the Transfer on the full market value of the land conveyed.

Subsection 68(3) of the Act provides that the contracted resale of a property, prior to its conveyance to an original purchaser, to any other person other than the original purchaser, will be chargeable with duty as:

- a conveyance to the original purchaser on the consideration for the sale; and
- a conveyance by the original purchaser to the sub purchaser on the consideration for the sale.
