

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

### **Delegates Embrace** Documentation Update


Friday 12th February hosted the first Society **Document Update for** 2010.

The mood in the Osmond Room at The Arkaba was very positive in fact vibrant as important issues that had become evident especially since the introduction of the Real Estate Industry Reform Bill and changes to the Form 1 had surfaced.


Chris Gill, Conveyancer with Corsers Solicitors, presented two and a half hours of hands-on practical training relating

to day to day issues that Agents face and addressed areas where contracts had failed due to errors and omissions and lack of knowledge, understanding and care in document preparation.

When asked at the end of the session what issues seemed to cause the most concern. Chris Gill commented: "The actual completion of the Form 1, given its complexity. The information provided by statutory authorities being not always actuate and skill is required in interpreting that information and knowing when



Comments made to CEO Garry Topp were that they loved Chris Gill's presentation because he delivered his presentation as a practitioner from within the industry and gave practical advice as how to best deal with how to complete the documents and does not dwell on the legal aspects of the legislation, but how to just get on and do it!


